Mai-Kai to Debut 2010 Children's Show Sundays in summer dedicated to families

Ft. Lauderdale, FL (May 27, 2010) – Sundays at the Mai-Kai Restaurant will soon feature family fun full of new twists, turns and leaps in the *Kids 2010 Islander Revue*. "We have many new children this year and they have learned the new dance steps very quickly. Of course, it also helps that we have several experienced children who can encourage our new members. The smiles and the self-confidence I see in their faces is so beautiful," said Thornton.

All ages, from grandparents to young children, enjoy the Mai-Kai's colorful and exciting 45-minute Islander Revue. At one point during the show the Mai-Kai dancers invite audience members to join them on stage to learn just a few of the basic dance moves.

Children under 12 years old enjoy the show at no charge. The adults show is only \$10.95. Each child receives a lei and a Polynesian activity and coloring book to take home. In addition, the Mai-Kai has a **special menu tailored to children's tastes** including Captain Cook's Ribs, Society Island Shrimp, Bora Bora Beef and Kon Tiki Chicken.
